## Search Results Page – Cases – Content Types & Label

- 1) Content types placed on top, coming from product design team
- 2) Added a Label, Page Heading, Selection Cue for the user so apart from the selected menu item the user can establish a change and the identity of the current location even if another menu item is clicked.

*Number of results* found in this content type acts as secondary information supporting the document title

## Search Results Page – Search Options & User Tools

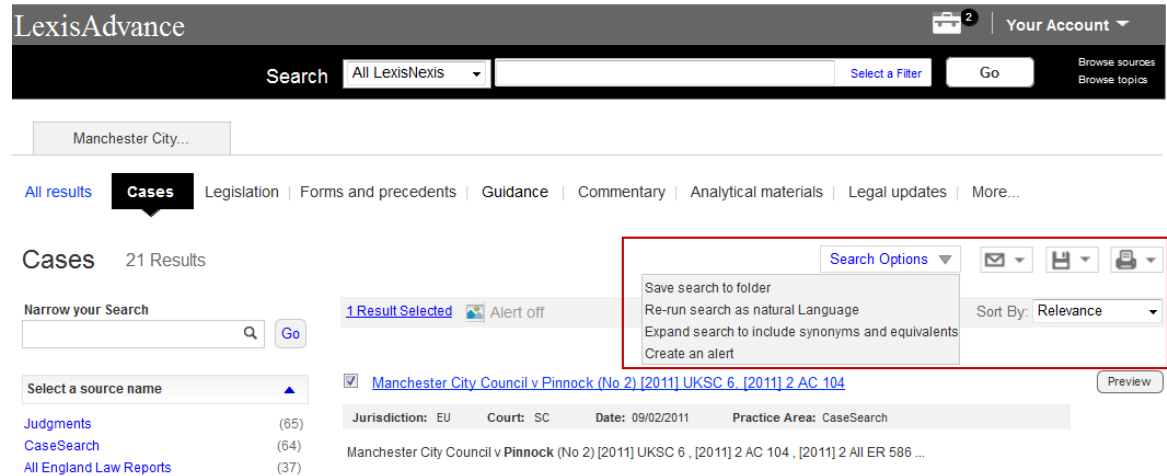
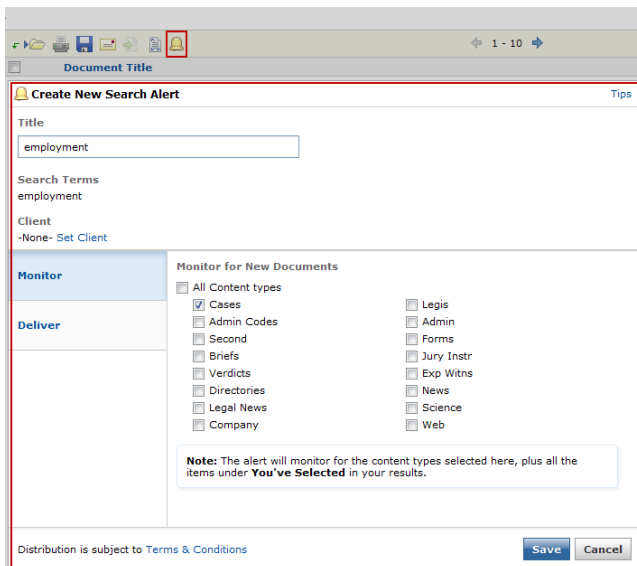
Some of the search options within the list:

That is already placed on the content navigation bar



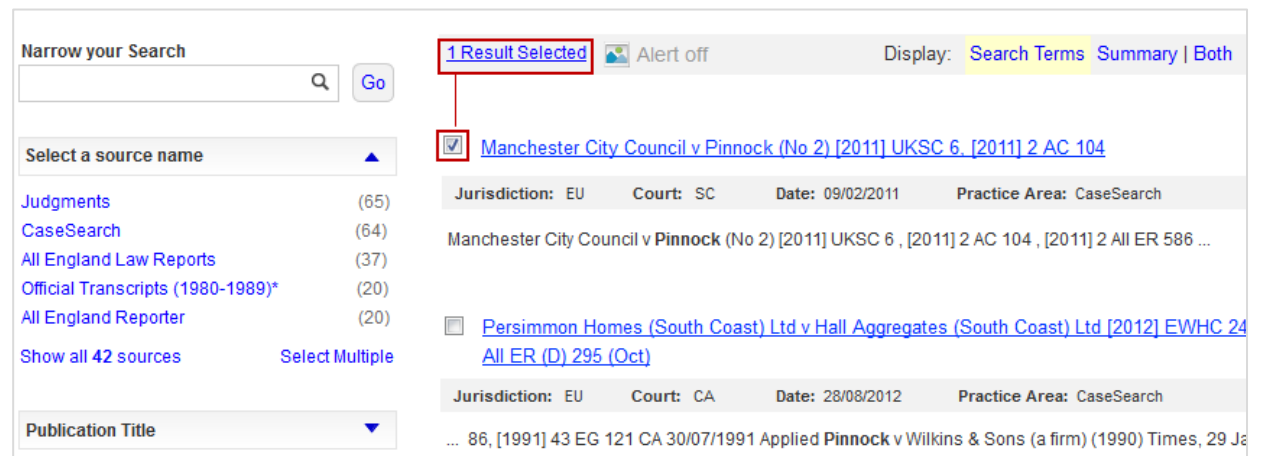
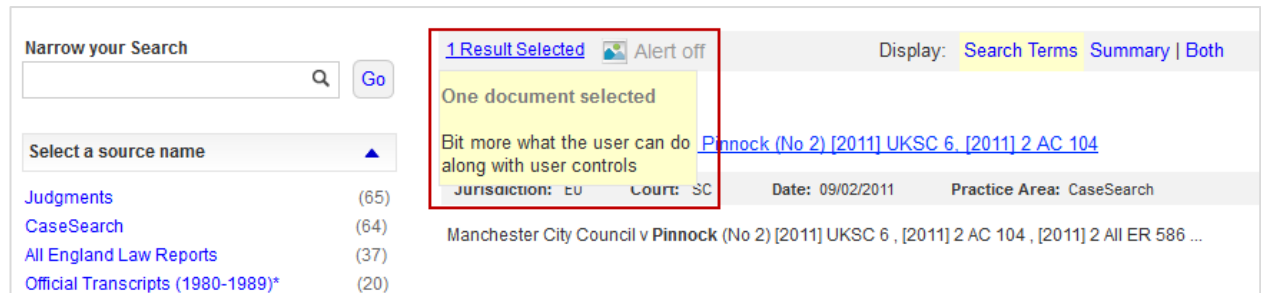
### Note:

## Search Results Page – Selecting a Search Result

### Selecting a search result:

- 1) By Default the user alert message is turned off
- 2) “1 result selected” Selection message only appears when the selection is made. It also displays a pop up with user message information on available options
- 3) The appearance of *Result selection* and popup would gain user attention with a visual cue informing the user as to what he can do next by clicking on the link
- 4) The pop up disappears after a few seconds
- 5) The **Alert** may have similar functionality; I personally would like to go for progressive disclosure showing if a certain link is clicked. Or with this one it just turns on if a summary link(s) is clicked (displaying a similar change cue would help in case the user develops a blind spot)



## Search Results Page – Display & Sorting (Feedback)

### Display:

The labels are subject to change

- 1) Display acts globally for results switching on/off Summary and/or Search terms (best para) for all results



- 2) The First iteration is taken from Lexis Advance showing links that work as 3 state toggle

- 3) Second iteration shows a checkbox



- 4) Third Iteration shows a standard dropdown



## Search Results Page – Filters

---

- All filters are placed on the Left column of the search page. They show collapsible menu items Displaying links and the number of results achieved.
- Based on the nature of the content presented within these filters I have increased the width of the left filter column. Would recommend using larger widths much like the blog style widths found on twitter, linked in etc which can accommodate widths beyond.
- I have asked for more content help from product so we can see how actual data would be implemented within this

## Search Results Page – Results Information

- The search result information consist of a Title, best para or summary, practice area and judgement date etc. Apart from the title and best paragraph the rest are to be decided.
- Every search result would have a preview button on the right. The interaction and behaviour of this button is still to be determined.

- **Second iteration** of the result page would show any supporting data (jurisdiction, court, date etc) to be placed under the title and best para. This would enable quick scanning and readability if that supporting data is not important enough to be placed underneath the title.

Need **feedback** from product to decide on this.

## Document View - Cases

Based on the law of proximity, all controls are placed within the document tab and close to the content

- 1) **Table of Contents:** Responsive based on content requirement it may or may not be present in document view for cases.
- 2) **Add to Library:** When checked this checkbox would show an alert that a document is selected. In Lexis advance it shows as checkbox next to document title. This could mean “Save to work Folder” as this may get saved in your personal profile and hence can be part of user options as well. Within the wireframe it would show a pop-up acting as visual cue for the user just like an alert in the previous section.
- 3) **Tools & Menu Items:** User options “Tools” menu items are to be determined, sitting next to email, save and print buttons in the right hand corner of the document content area.

---

### 4) Right Column – Related Content

This column hosts all related content /links associated to the document.

- a) A block displaying signals and the option of Show/hide signals with perhaps a signal label
- b) Content block containing information like Alternate renditions, Author Information links etc
- c) If that particular Case document has related Citator Links. They can be more than one
- d) Parallel Citations (Reporter Links) These are more than one.  
Both; parallel citations and Legislation Citator use sliders. If the content can grow beyond 4-5 items then we can introduce scrollable sliders so we don't need to push down to accommodate large numbers.  
**Note: Need to check with product if these lists can accommodate large number of items.**
- e) This document belongs to: This block will contain all recommended Practice area modules
- f) Related Documents: All editorially injected related document links would be part of this content block

### 5) Document Menu

This menu bar sits on top of the document content. It has the following:

- a) Intra-document navigation: Jumping from one section to another within the document
- b) Search term navigation (**Note: This can be done differently to make it more user friendly and engaging**)
- c) Pagination Control: Skipping to specific pages within the document

## Document View – Cases Citator

The citatory document view looks quite like a normal document.

Some customisation in the right column related content. Signals can have Hide All Signals Link.

**Note: Other customisation would require feedback.**

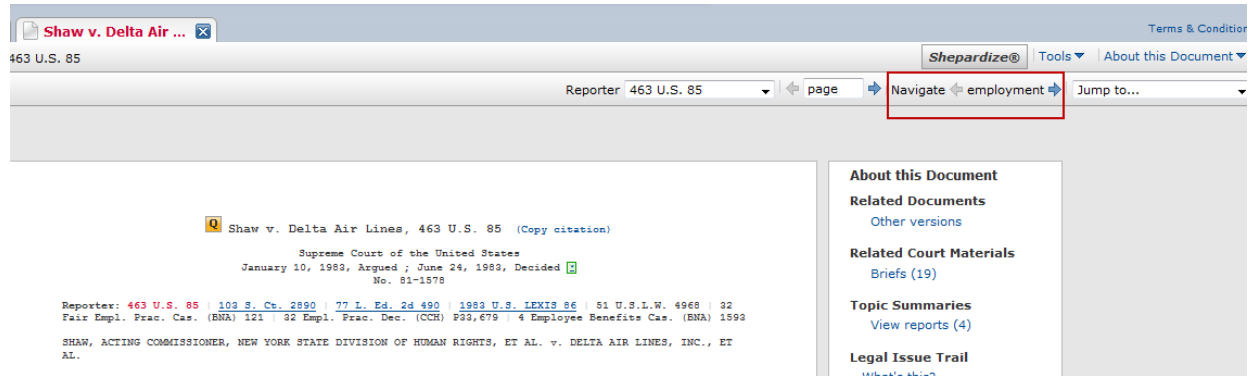

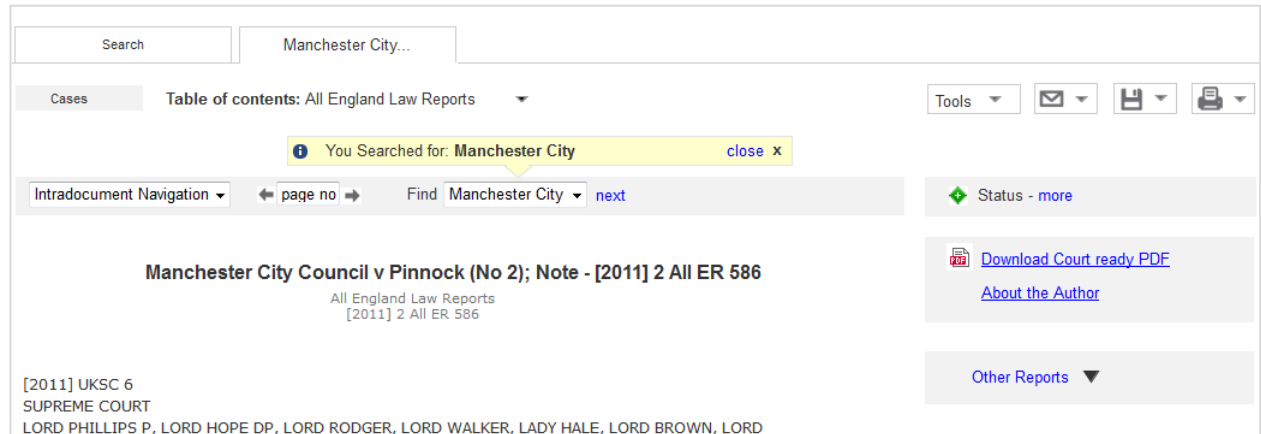
Quite unclear what is required of the user; rethinking search term navigation component for Lexis Advance...



## Suggestions

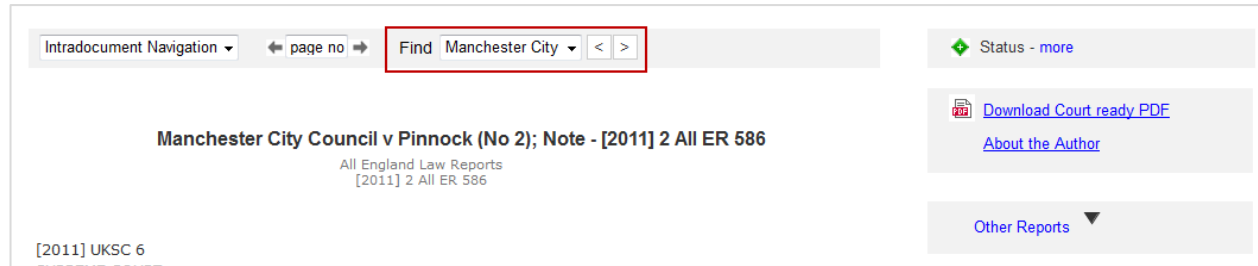
It may help if these components are fixed and the page scrolls to highlight the occurrence.

If you are following up on a search then a tooltip may help in getting attention towards the search component. This can be timer based.



## Search Term Navigation – Suggestions & Samples

If we'd rather have arrows than making these arrows look like buttons and placing them together would help as the user is being asked to: read the label (find); select a list item (Manchester City) and then click a next/previous button.



Previous on the first click would just do nothing. We can also start by having one forward arrow and upon going to the first instance we can display previous arrow.

Keeping it simple for the user and only displaying next and previous buttons/links if the user clicks on the FIND button/link.

The focus shifts to the first occurrence and a control box would pop open displaying search term and previous/next buttons.
